- 3. Efforts may be made to get signatures of the more advanced-age pensioners at the beginning of the paper.
- 4. When obtaining out-station signatures, care may be taken to keep all papers neat and clean.
- 5. Date may be entered on the petition before the dispatch without fail.
- 6. Papers may not be folded. A large envelope with proper address may be used.
- 7. If all petitions are signed as on 15th August 2015 and sent by courier on August 17, the receiving Officer can process it in one go and may not feel much botheration.
- 8. Signatures may be obtained from Natioalized banks, S.B. I. and the Associate Banks pensioners.
- 9. A scanned copy of the signed papers may kindly be mailed to me. I shall inform you the final number of signatories in due course.

Your enthusiastic work for this Petition will make this effort impressive. The petition is drafted after conferring with many in person and by mail.
